

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

12th International GO Group Workshop

1. Definitions and Organizer

1.1. The conference entitled “**12th International GO Group Workshop**” (hereinafter referred to as the “**Event**”) is organized by:

YOUROPE e.V. – The European Festival Association,
Breite Str. 38, 53111 Bonn, Germany
(hereinafter referred to as the “**Organizer**”).

2. Date and Venue

2.1. The Event shall take place on **13 and 14 April 2026** at:

Museum of Modern Art in Warsaw
ul. Marszałkowska 103
00-110 Warsaw, Poland
(hereinafter referred to as the “**Venue**”).

3. Ticket Sales

3.1. Ticket sales for the Event shall be conducted by:

Alter Art Festival sp. z o.o.,
ul. Kazimierzowska 14, 02-589 Warsaw, Poland,
entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw,
KRS No. 227624, NIP: 586-214-15-57, share capital: PLN 50,000
(hereinafter referred to as the “**Seller**”),

via the Fantix ticketing platform available at www.fantix.pl (hereinafter referred to as the “**Service**”).

3.2. The sale of Tickets shall be governed by the ticket sales regulations applicable in the Service.

3.3. All Ticket prices shall be denominated in **Polish zloty (PLN)**. The Seller shall not be liable for any exchange rate fluctuations or banking fees arising from currency conversion.

4. Tickets

4.1. Tickets shall be **personal (named)** and valid for participation in the Event on **both Event days only**. Single-day Tickets shall not be offered.

4.2. The Ticket price includes:

- (a) participation in the two-day workshop programme; and
- (b) light lunch on each day of the Event.

4.3. The Ticket does not include admission to any exhibitions or other events available at the Venue.

5. Refund Policy

5.1. Tickets may be refunded exclusively until **30 March 2026**.

5.2. Refunds shall be processed in **PLN** only. The Seller shall not be responsible for any exchange rate differences or bank charges incurred by the Participant.

6. Admission and Wristbands

6.1. Upon first entry to the Event, each Ticket shall be exchanged for an **Event wristband** (hereinafter referred to as the “Identifier”).

6.2. The Identifier shall entitle the Participant to attend the Event on both Event days.

6.3. Admission to the Event shall be granted solely to Participants wearing an **undamaged Identifier permanently affixed to the wrist**.

7. Verification and Named Tickets

7.1. By purchasing a Ticket, the Participant acknowledges and accepts these Terms and Conditions and all applicable Event regulations.

7.2. A named Ticket entitles admission exclusively to the person whose full name was provided during the purchase process.

7.3. The Ticket shall be subject to verification upon each entry to the Event.

7.4. Exchange of a Ticket for an Identifier and admission to the Event shall be permitted only upon presentation of a valid Ticket containing a legible barcode and numerical code.

8. Compliance with Venue Rules

8.1. Participants shall comply at all times with the Venue’s rules and regulations available at:

9. Recording and Use of Image

9.1. The Organizer reserves the right to photograph and record the Event for documentation, marketing and promotional purposes, including in future editions of the Event.

9.2. By participating in the Event, each Participant grants the Organizer a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence to use their image and voice recorded during the Event for the purposes specified in Clause 9.1, without any right to remuneration.

10. Liability

10.1. The Organizer and the Seller shall not be liable for any loss, damage or injury suffered by Participants except where such liability cannot be excluded under applicable law.

10.2. Participation in the Event shall be at the Participant’s own risk.

11. Governing Law

11.1. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Poland.

12. Final Provisions

12.1. These Terms and Conditions constitute the entire agreement between the Organizer and the Participant regarding participation in the Event.

12.2. Any matters not expressly regulated herein shall be governed by applicable provisions of Polish law.

These Terms and Conditions shall become effective as of 17 February 2026.
